**Subject: Call for candidates for TC CYBER WG EUSR Chair and Vice-Chair**

Pursuant to the adoption by the EU of [Regulation \(EU\) 2024/2847](#) on horizontal cybersecurity requirements for products with digital elements and amending Regulations (EU) No 168/2013 and (EU) 2019/1020 and Directive (EU) 2020/1828 (Text with EEA relevance), the Cyber Resilience Act (CRA), and following the positive opinion of the Committee of Standards on the draft standardisation request in support of this Regulation (CRA SR), ETSI, CEN and CENELEC expect to receive notification from the EC of this standardisation request shortly. ETSI Board and OCG assigned the Technical Committee on Cybersecurity (TC CYBER) as Lead Technical Committee to coordinate the development of standards internally within ETSI and with CEN and CENELEC in response to this standardisation request. For this purpose, TC CYBER has created a specific Working Group named EUSR. CYBER-EUSR meetings are currently convened by TC CYBER Officials.

A call for candidates for the Chair and Vice-Chair positions of this CYBER-EUSR Working Group is currently open from 27 January 2025 until 24 February 2025. The call for candidates is available here:

The CYBER-EUSR working group shall be responsible for delivering several harmonised vertical standards, jointly with other ETSI, CEN and CENELEC relevant technical groups. These work items notably include IoT security standards (smart home virtual assistants, smart home products with security functionality, connected toys, personal wearable products for health/well-being monitoring) telecommunications products security standards (Routers, modems and switches, VPNs, firewalls, hypervisors) as well as generic standards for browsers, operating systems, antivirus, passwords, etc.
